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- 1. Illinois Department of Public Health. Link to the Illinois Department of Public Health web site.
- 2. What's New. Displays new enhancements and data updates.
- 3. Description. Defines IPLAN and explains the IPLAN process.
- 4. Contact Us. Sends a comment to the IPLAN staff.
- 5. County-level Report. Retrieves yearly data for one indicator for one or more counties. The counties may be listed individually or aggregated.
- County summary Report. Retrieves all the indicators for one county and one data year.
- 7. Community-level Report. Retrieves yearly data for one indicator for one or more communities. The communities may be listed individually or aggregated.
- 8. Community summary. Retrieves all the indicators for one community and one data year.
- 9. Javaä version. An alternative method of running data reports.
- 10. Indicator Details. Displays detailed information for each indicator. Information includes the data source, data definition, lists the years of data available and specifies if data can be aggregated.
- **11. About....** Contains an introduction and overview of the IPLAN Data System with brief descriptions of each indicator category and other prominent data sources.
- 12. SHARE Report. Displays local health department health assessment results from the IPLAN process.
- 13. Helpful Examples. Provides examples of how to run a SHARE report.
- 14. Description. Provides an explanation of SHARE.
- 15. Search IPLAN site. Searches the IPLAN site by entering a search term.
- 16. IPLAN Training. Displays a listing of training documents.
- **17. Message Board.** Provides an open forum message board for posting messages and viewing responses.
- **18. Recertification Guidelines.** Documents the suggested guidelines for IPLAN recertification.
- 19. Administrative Code. Documents the state code requirements.
- 20. Other Links. Links to other web sites that can be used for additional data resources.

- 1. Department. Lists the health department that submitted the priority.
- 2. Region. Lists the IDPH region.
- 3. Phone Number. Specifies the local health department's phone number.
- 4. E-mail. Specifies the local health department's e-mail address. This line is omitted if an e-mail address is not available.
- 5. Website. Lists the local health department's web site address. This line is omitted if a web site is not available.
- 6. Record #1 of #2. Lists the health priorities contained in the report; the first number represents the current record and the second number represents the total number of health priorities in the report.
- 7. Top of page, back. (Also included but not shown are "previous record" and "next record".) Provides navigation through the report.
- 8. IPLAN Round. Specifies the IPLAN round in which the priority was submitted.
- 9. Priority. Specifies the name of the health priority submitted by the health department.
- 10. Outcome Objective. Specifies the outcome objective for the health priority.
- 11. Impact Objective. Specifies the impact objective for the health priority.
- 12. Interventions. Specifies the intervention strategies for the health priority.

- Indicator code and name.
- 2. Specifies the data represented in the report. In this example, #9, #11 and #13 are 5-year average ageadjusted rates and #10 and #12 are 5-year numbers.
- Specifies the data year.
- 4. Specifies the county/community selected and serves as the column heading for the county/community data.
- 5. Column heading for Illinois data.
- 6. Column heading for U.S. data, if U.S. data is available.
- 7. Column heading for Healthy People 2010 Objective.
- 8. Data categories. Data for each category is provided.
- 9. The rate or percent data value for the county/community for the year specified. In this example, these numbers are 5-year average age-adjusted rates, determined by using #1 and #2.
- 10. The number of events that occurred for the county/community. In this example, these numbers represent 5-year numbers, also known as the number of events, occurring in the year specified in #3. Use #1 and #2 to determine the data label.
- 11. The rate or percent data value for the state of Illinois. In this report, these numbers are 5-year average ageadjusted rates.
- 12. The number of events that occurred for the state of Illinois. In this example, these numbers are 5-year numbers, or the number of events occurring in the year specified in #3.
- 13. The rate or percent data value for the United States. In this report, these numbers are 5-year average ageadjusted rates.
- 14. Healthy People 2010 Objective, if available.
- 15. Note about the indicator.
